

Through her guidance, the program has become more than just a safe place for students to go after school. It is an interactive learning environment that provides a multitude of handson experiences such as Science, Technology, Engineering, and **Mathematics (STEM)** activities. Children are eager

to attend, engaged while in the classroom, and sad when they have to go home. Principal Kelli Reeves commented, "Sierra View and the after school program is grateful to have Ursula on our team. She is an exceptional champion for students." Ms. Newcomb connects school and afterschool academics by consulting with teachers to support them and assist students in the program to succeed. She oversees behavioral and academic needs for special and general education students. Her primary role, is to assess and determine eligibility for Special Education students. She helps to develop Behavior Intervention Plans and Individualized Education Plans. She assists the Resource Specialist Program in supporting children with learning disabilities by giving them strategies to help with their educational success. She has helped to promote district wide awareness of Adverse Childhood

Experiences (ACE's) regarding its effects and the components of care that have proven to heal the stress caused by ACE's. She is a member of the Cal-HOPE Social Emotional Community of Practice, which is bringing social emotional curriculum to campuses throughout Madera. Ms. Grewal commented, "Putting the stress aside, the rewards are plentiful and when I see my students succeed, it brings so much joy to my heart... Many of them run toward me to greet me with a hug, sometimes it brings tears to my eyes because this unconditional love is the biggest and most priceless reward."
