FIND THE MONEY

Students in Kindergarten and 1st grade are just starting to learn about money. This workshop is customized for the specific needs of each class. At this developmental level, students learn to identify coins and basic saving and spending principles. The workshop is taught in a fun and engaging way, using age-appropriate lesson plans.



FUN WITH MONEY

Students from 1st – 6th grade will enjoy this workshop designed to create an awareness of money-related topics. Characteristics found in U.S. and foreign currency, how ancient cultures dealt with barter systems and early forms of money are discussed in a way that engages the students and promotes a dialogue.
